



JAKE 350

JAKE 350 is strong enough for a 3-point fastening crane up to a 45 kNm gross lifting moment. The crane can be with, or without, hydraulic legs. A light harvester use is also permitted.

Compared with a crane mounted on a trailer, **JAKE 350** increases useful load on the trailer. That's because the weight of the crane is not on the load, but on the pulling wheels. **JAKE** Boom support increases the pulling power still more, because the biggest part of the weight of the crane is possible to turn to the front axle of the tractor.



JAKE 350 also makes your crane use more versatile, because you don't need to use just that one trailer but you can use a crane also with other machines. Some limitations might come, but usually the reason is a crane, not **JAKE**.
